If entering an amateur class, a photocopy of your current 2010 USEF Amateur card is required with entry. A copy of your 2010 RMDS Horse/Rider/ Owner card must be submitted for scores to count for qualifying for RMDS Championships and year-end awards. No drug fee, non-member fee, or bridle tag deposit. entries to the show secretary. Make checks payable to BV Dressage. \$30 bad check fee plus any collection/bank fees. **Proof of negative Coggins taken within 12 months required with entry.**
REFUNDS: Full refund up to closing date. After closing date, only the class fees will be refunded if the ride is filled. No refund due to acts of nature.

AWARDS: Both shows: Ribbons to be awarded through 6th place. High Point Award for training through 2nd level, all three divisions (Open, Adult Amateur, Jr./Young Rider)

STABLING: Limited stabling available at facility. Contact the show manager.

TIMES: Tentative times will be emailed or mailed (you need to send a self addressed stamped envelope). Secretary will **not** call ride times. Also ride times will be posted on the website: www.bvdressage.org

ARENAS/FOOTING: Singletree warm up is out door with lounging in designated areas only. Indoor-Singletree-sand/dirt; Somerset-granite deposit - both outdoor arenas-granite & dirt. (Intro thru Training Level classes may be in a small ring). Singletree-in case of inclement weather, warm-up will be held indoors.

OTHER: Farrier/Vet on call. EMT will be on site during the show. NO DOGS! Any dog found will be confiscated and the owner charged \$50 as a donation to the Denver Dumb Friends League. All day concessions will be provided.

DIRECTIONS: Singletree: From Boulder: East on Arapahoe 1/2 mile east of 75th St. From Lafayette: Arapahoe Road west 1 1/2 miles from 95th St. **Somerset:** From Boulder – North on HWY 36 (Foothills Hwy) about 8 miles north of Boulder, Right (East) on Nelson Road, on left side soon after S curve.
